For the first time the Vienna University of Technology and the University of Vienna grant a **scholarship** for the postgraduate **Executive MBA Program Mergers & Acquisitions** to Alumni from **Emerging Markets**.

It is a matter of concern of both universities to award one scholarship for qualified persons originated in “Emerging Markets”. This specialised grant will give individuals the possibility to get further academic education, to perfect a foreign language and to achieve intercultural competence. By granting this scholarship the Vienna University of Technology and the University of Vienna are supporting the education of excellent managers from CEE and other Emerging Markets.

The postgraduate program lasts 3 semesters (14 months) and is held in English. Internationally distinguished experts are members of the faculty – both as a result of their scientific knowledge and their extensive practical experience. Furthermore, the FIBAA* seal of quality is awarded to the EMBA Mergers & Acquisitions.

The Vienna University of Technology and the University of Vienna grant **one 50% Scholarship** in the amount of EUR 14,000 to Alumni of technical, economical or juristical studies. The participation of the scholarship holder is EUR 14,000. Any recourse of law is excluded. Admitted individuals must hold an academic degree along with a minimum of five years of work experience and adequate knowledge of English language.
