The ENERGY GLOBE Award is today's most prominent environmental prize worldwide. It distinguishes projects regionally, nationally and globally that conserve resources such as energy and utilize renewable or emission-free sources. The ENERGY GLOBE Award is today's most prestigious environmental prize worldwide.

The goal of the ENERGY GLOBE Award is to create the necessary awareness concerning solutions to our environmental problems and to demonstrate that each of us can make a positive contribution. The winning ENERGY GLOBE projects serve as examples. These are presented in the ENERGY GLOBE project database as well as on the ENERGY GLOBE Portal. In addition, the ENERGY GLOBE Portal offers solutions for all of us.

At the ENERGY GLOBE Award Gala, the best solutions are placed in the spotlight of international television broadcasts: in 2007 and 2008 the venue of the awards ceremony for the (inter) national ENERGY GLOBE winners was the Plenary Hall of the European Parliament in Brussels with the support of prominent people from all over the world. Highlight 2009 during the Czech EU Presidency: on April 14 the ENERGY GLOBE gala was opening event of the informal meeting of the EU Environmental Ministers in Prague. The participation in the ENERGY GLOBE 2009 was overwhelming: 105 countries submitted more than 800 projects.

Due to the importance of this environmental award the European Parliament wants to establish the ENERGY GLOBE as regular event on the European Agenda and annually host the gala at the Plenary Hall in Brussels.

Overview of the ENERGY GLOBE Award

- The environmental prize has been awarded annually since 2000.
- ENERGY GLOBE winners are distinguished in the realm of the international ENERGY GLOBE TV gala.
- Venues to date include Japan, Canada und twice in the European Parliament in Brussels.
- The award is presented in the categories Earth, Fire, Water, Air and Youth.
- The monetary prize for first place in the international award is 10 000 euro per category.
- In all some 6000 projects have been submitted for the ENERGY GLOBE Award.
- The ENERGY GLOBE Jury is headed by Congresswoman Maneka Gandhi, former Indian Minister for Environment.
- International personalities such as former Secretary General of the UN Kofi Annan, former Russian President Mikhail Gorbachev, Maneka Gandhi, European Parliament President Dr. Hans-Gert Pöttering, EU Commission President José Manuel Barroso, Hollywood actor Martin Sheen, Bollywood star Aamir Khan, Peter Falk (Columbo), Alanis Morissette, Dionne Warwick, Robin Gibb (Bee Gees), and Zucchero, to name but a few, offer their services for the ENERGY GLOBE Award.
