Entry regulations:

Entry regulations can be changed at short notice. Hence, passengers are requested to check the entry regulation of the destination before their flight **here**.

Based on Austria's policy, a <u>Digital entry form</u> should be filled out prior to the journey by all passengers whose final destination is Austria.

PCR test requirements for departures from Imam Khomeini Airport:

- If the final destination country needs a negative PCR test, then all passengers must present a negative PCR test at check-in counters in Imam Khomeini Airport
- Negative PCR test must be in English, on Paper with date and time of the test and stamp from a Laboratory
- o The test may be provided from all verified laboratories of health ministry
- The proof of the negative Covid-19 test must not be older than 72 hours at the time of entering Austria
- The PCR test shall fit into the respective destination's policies
- If the final destination country accepts vaccinated passengers, then Austrian Airlines will board vaccinated passengers who have completed their vaccination series of BioNTech/Pfizer, Moderna, AstraZeneca, Johnson & Johnson, Sinopharm and Sinovac A proof of vaccination is mandatory.
- Only type of test accepted is PCR Test
