











International headquarters



Productivity 12% above EU average rank 5 in the EU Motivation apprenticeship, dual education Education vocational schools unique to Austria Schools (HAK, HTL) broad network, 16 private 22 public and 21 Universities universities of applied sciences Labour law modern and flexible





- There is no general minium wage, minimum wages regulated in sectoral agreements
- Wages paid 14 times per year
- Calculation of total labour cost: (gross wage*14) + 30%
- Working hours: 38.5 or 40 hours / week (excluding lunch break)
- Usually 25 days vacation per year
- New system for severance payments no need for provisions
- Employees may be dismissed without stating a cause









R&D Expenditures Grow Above Average

As a percentage of GDP




