








1. Austrian subsidiaries in Slovenia: participant profile







Total turnover in million EUR




2. From your company's perspective, how would you characterize the current economic climate and state of the economy in Slovenia?



Past 12 months (2022)




3. Looking at your company's performance in Slovenia, how would you assess the indicators listed below?




4. Looking at your experience in Slovenia, how would you assess the factors listed below? (1/2)



5. What measures is your company taking to combat the lack of skilled workers?



Key takeaways

- Austrian investors in Slovenia are satisfied with their performances and achievements in 2022, but skeptical about the economic outlook. A decline in total turnover, orders and capacity utilization is expected.
- The commitment to Slovenia as a business location remains high. Companies are very satisfied with the
 quality and availability of local suppliers. Infrastructure, digitization, quality awareness and payment
 discipline are also rated very positive.
- Bureaucracy, tax burden on companies, lack of skilled workers and high costs of raw materials remain the critical points of the investment environment.
- Room for improvement is seen in a more predictable economic policy, in labor law and the fight against corruption.
- The shortage of skilled labor is a growing problem, identified by 62% of respondents. To combat the shortage of skilled workers, companies are investing in training and retraining their employees, raising salaries above the industry average and increasing automation/digitization.
- 78% of Austrian entrepreneurs in Slovenia believe that the country remains very attractive as a business location. Further investments by Austrian companies are planned in 2023.







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
