The world ski market

Accounting for ski countries may vary according to the definition of skiing and of a ski area. There are currently 68 countries in the world that offer equipped outdoor ski areas covered with snow.

Ski resorts and infrastructure

According to the latest inventory, 5'764 ski areas have been identified worldwide (equipped outdoor ski areas covered with snow). As some only offer rudimentary equipment, with a limited number of lifts. Those 1'945 areas that feature more than 4 lifts are qualified as ski resorts. It is estimated that the industry currently offers about 6 million commercial beds in the mountains. These are primarily concentrated in the industrialized ski markets, which have a high volume of skier visits












World ski market















repartition of skier visits worldwide





Ddistribution of skiers by region of origin. The Alps is the most internationally visited ski destination, attracting most of the inbound skier travel.

Even though it hosts 40% of skier visits, it only produces 16% of the skiers.








Since beginning of 2000s, yearly visitation to ski resorts varies mainly due to weather conditions and has been fluctuating between 350 and 380 million skier visits worldwide.













Slovenia has 28 peaks over 2'000 meters high. The highest one, Triglav, culminates at 2'864 meters above sea level. The Alps, including the Julian Alps, the Kamnik-Savinja Alps and the Karavanke mountain range, tower above Northern Slovenia along its long border with Austria and Italy. In the 17th century, skis were already used there as a means of transportation. Today, hiking and trekking are among the most preferred sports in Slovenia. Thanks to attractive winter resorts such as Kranjska Gora, Rogla and Krvavec, skiing has developed into a major sport in the past few decades, even though other European winter sport destinations are strong competitors due to higher altitudes and the guaranteed snow. Tourism is the highest growing economic sector in Slovenia and is increasingly competitive












Map of the Mountain resorts in Slovenia













Slovenia has 61 resorts with a total of over 200 ski lifts. It offers a very good price/performance ratio, modern ski runs, cross-country skiing, good infrastructure, snowmaking, and well equipped holiday apartments and hotels.

Mariborsko Pohorje is one of the most well-known resorts. It hosts an alpine World Cup ladies' downhill event every year. 43 kilometres of ski runs, modern spas, beautiful landscapes and being near the city of Maribor make this a very attractive destination. The resort guarantees 100 snow days per season.

Kranjska Gora. It hosts an alpine skiing World Cup event every year and has trails for every level, from beginners to expert skiers and snowboarders.

The highest winter resort in Slovenia is Kanin, which is connected with the Italian resort of Sella Never. It offers 30 kilometers of ski runs, 13 lifts and snow through early spring.

Cerkno is the most modern family ski resort in Slovenia, located on the slopes of the 1'291-metre high Črni vrh peak. This ideally situated ski area is 100% covered by an extensive snowmaking system, which guarantees a minimum of 70 ski days per winter






Figure 16: Slovenia, evolution of skier visits








