

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

The basis of our philosophy is organic farming. We firmly believe that organically farmed vineyards produce more harmonious wines in the glass. Our approach to winemaking at the Groszer Wein winery sounds simple. As little as possible, as much as necessary and with a lot of gut feeling. On the one hand, this means that we do without some oenological aids. Our wines have to make do with what the vineyard has given them. Secondly, we rely on our senses. We don't pick the grapes when they have reached a certain sugar level, but when they taste good to us. Sounds romantic and simple, but it requires a lot of experience and sensitivity. In the cellar, careful handling of the grapes is the be-all and end-all. Grapes are not pumped. That's why we do a lot of lifting, tipping and, if there's no other way, shoveling.

Our flagship vineyard, Ried Zieregg, is celebrated for producing complex, mineral-driven wines. Tement practices biodynamic viticulture and has been Demeter-certified since 2022, emphasizing sustainability and harmony with nature. Our vineyards span both Austrian and Slovenian territories, with Domaine Ciringa representing our Slovenian holdings. In addition to Sauvignon Blanc, Tement cultivates varieties like Morillon (Chardonnay), Weissburgunder (Pinot Blanc), and Gelber Muskateller. Our wines are crafted with minimal intervention, allowing the unique terroir to shine through. Weingut Tement is a member of the "Steirische Terroir- und Klassikweingüter" association, dedicated to promoting regional wine culture.

The Kracher Winery located in Illmitz within Austria's Seewinkel region, is internationally renowned for its exceptional noble sweet wines. When Alois Kracher passed away in 2007, the entire wine world mourned. Tributes appeared in the Financial Times, Robert Parker and in Jancis Robinson's column - to name only a few. His legacy as a pioneer and visionary will continue to inspire many generations to come. Since 2007, Gerhard Kracher continues the winery that his grandfather founded and his father made famous around the world. He is also capable of producing astonishing red wine cuvée and vibrant, dry white wine. Both came from the same vineyards in Burgenland.

Sohm & Kracher Winery, Aldo Sohm and Gerhard Kracher have been close friends for over a decade. The idea to produce a wine together - under the name of Sohm & Kracher - began in 2009. As with many great ideas, the wine was created during a wine and dining experience. Both Gerhard and Aldo cherish indigenous grape varieties and they have a soft spot for Grüner Veltliner. The origin of the grapes for the wine is Weinviertel, where old vines are found growing on unique soil formations. The first wine was a single varietal Grüner Veltliner, and it was a huge success. Top ratings appeared virtually immediately in international magazines like Wine & Spirits.

Christoph Hoch is the twelth generation, since 1640, to make wine in his town of Hollenburg, on the south side of the Danube. Today Hoch has 12 hectares total, all in Hollenburg, and all farmed biodynamically and certified by Demeter. Christoph has mostly Grüner Veltliner planted, along with Riesling, Zweigelt, Weissburgunder, Blauer Portugesier, and Muskat Ottonel. He studies his terroir and after discovering the Hollenburger conglomerate is high in active limestone, giving wines with a high acidity, he had the idea to focus on sparkling wine, which represents 75% of his production. Christoph Hoch has an infectious enthusiasm and that energy comes through in the wines.

Claus Preisinger has been passionately making wine on the picturesque north shore of Lake Neusiedl in the charming Burgenland town of Gols since the year 2002. In a notable move towards sustainability, he converted the vineyards and winery to biodynamic production in 2006, and today he proudly holds the prestigious Respekt Biodyn certification. Claus vinifies a variety of mostly domestic grape varieties, including Blaufränkisch, Zweigelt, Grüner Veltliner, and St. Laurent, all of which are complemented by selections of Pinot Noir and Pinot Blanc sourced from both the west and east sides of beautiful Lake Neusiedl. In a testament to his commitment to purity, Claus does not use any cultivated yeast, and he practices only very slight or no dosing of sulphur dioxide in his winemaking process. He takes the innovative approach of aging many of his wines in amphora rather than traditional wooden barrels, which he views as a conscious step back, allowing for a reduction to the essential elements - the grape and the soil. Reduction, minimalism, and a free spirit are the guiding themes that encapsulate the philosophy and work of Claus Preisinger.

Martin Muthenthaler's vineyards are geographically located in the Wachau and at the same time far away from its epicentre. Muthenthaler is the genius loci of the Spitzer Graben. He is the proverbial hermit who lives at the end of this small valley. His grapes are not helped by the sun reflected from the Danube. Here the climate is cool even in summer while the vines are rooted in almost pure rock. The slate soil is the key here: it retains heat, allows the roots to penetrate deeply and provides excellent drainage. The impressive slopes of the Bruck are the perfect soil for great Rieslings and Grüner Veltliners. The well-integrated acidity lends tension and clarity to the deep, rich wines. The wines are smoky, calm and unforced. We are far from "textbook wines". Martin approached viticulture out of a need to look after his parents' three hectares. And he did so with a free and open mind.

There is hardly another vineyard that has shaped the perception of the Wachau as a serious high-quality wine-growing region as strongly as that of the Knoll family. Many generations of this family have dedicated their lives to growing wine: the first glass bottles were filled with Knoll wine in the 1950s, and the arguably most famous wine label in Austria – the family's trademark baroque image of Saint Urban – first graced the Knoll wine bottles in 1962. The family cultivates wine on sixteen hectares, and the names of his terraces have become common knowledge among both national and international wine drinkers: the Kellerberg, Loibenberg, Pfaffenberg and especially the Schütt yield the fruit for the famous range of Knoll Riesling and Veltliner, which are all clear, precise, mineral-rich and structured, frequently revealing their full potential after years or even decades.
